ELIGIBILITY AND QUALIFICATIONS

1. Those eligible to apply for this scholarship must be a student at a university, or college who are children or grandchildren of persons who are:
 - A. Regular, Associate or Life members of the American Power Dispatchers Association, Inc. who have been members in good standing for the preceding two years or;
 - B. A Deceased member of the American Power Dispatchers Association, Inc. who was a member in good standing at the time of death.
 - C. Not a previous recipient of this Scholarship.
2. The Scholarship winner will be determined by the Scholarship Committee. The Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of character, scholastic leadership, and other potentials for success in college and post college life. Financial need will not be considered in the selection of the scholarship recipient.
3. The student must apply for the scholarship, by completing this application. The student's application must be accompanied by two letters of recommendation and a copy of the applicants' current college transcripts.
4. The application and letters shall be sent to the Scholarship Chairperson, who, with the Scholarship Committee, will screen all applications. The Scholarship Committee will select the recipient of the scholarship award based on the information contained in this application. Failure to provide "all" requested information may disqualify an applicant.
5. Scholarship applications shall be postmarked by May 24th and in the possession of the Scholarship Committee by May 31st. It is recommended that the application be sent by registered mail.
