### **Southeast Area Trustee Report National APDA 2014 Fall Meeting**

The APDA SE Area Spring 2014 meeting was held in Point Clear, AL from May 11<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup>, 2014. The meeting was held at the Grand Hotel with providing 32 NERC CEH's. The first training day started with a welcome from APCo GM of Transmission Interconnections and Operations Ron Parsons. The conference was sponsored by TESLA Load Forecasting, Monitor Mapboard, and Primate Technologies. The training was provided by NERC, Livewire Compliance, Primate Technologies, TVA, and the SE APDA.

As of May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2014, the SE area has a checking balance of \$36,660.87. There is \$24,059.94 in savings. \$7,746.18 is allotted for the scholarship fund. This was reported by the area treasurer.

As of May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2014, the SE area has 303 members on roll, 177 in "good standing", 4 associate members, and 1 lifetime member as reported by the area secretary. The 2014 SE APDA Fall meeting will be held in Nashville, TN from October 6<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup>, 2014 and the spring conference will be held in Savannah, GA from May 11<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup>, 2015.
